NNTL is seeking to appoint a Resource Coach to work alongside the Northern Stars Head Coach and the Northern Comets Head Coach for the 2020 ANZ Premiership and 2020 National Netball League (NNL) programme.

RESOURCE COACH STARS POSITION DESCRIPTION:

The core purpose of the Resource Coach is to support the development and implementation of the performance programme and coaching plan in consultation with the Stars Head Coach and Assistant Coach; and foster a Performance environment.

For ANZ competition match play the Resource Coach will provide in game match analysis from the back bench at Auckland based games and remotely for away games and step into the Assistant Coach role if the Stars Assistant Coach has Comets commitments. This will be dependent upon the NNL draw which is yet to be released. The Resource Coach will also have input into post match and opposition analysis to support the growth and direction of the team.

The Resource Coach will lead and support Stars and Comets Core sessions as directed by the Northern Stars Coach. These sessions will be aligned to the successful applicant's skill set.

While the Head Coach of the Stars has overall responsibility of the performance programme, the Resource Coach will be an integral part of the coaching unit; leading their area of expertise and support the Head Coach throughout the campaign.

The coach will have the opportunity to work across both the Northern Stars and Northern Comets programmes with a planned roster and specific allocated tasks and responsibilities within each session.

More specifically the Resource Coach will:

1. Unreservedly support the Head Coach and Assistant Coach of the Stars and the franchise in a constructive manner.
 2. Assist with the development and implementation of the coaching plan and identify key components that align ANZ performance goals.
 3. Provide the Northern Stars Coach with timely and succinct observations when and where required.

4. Be a key driver in collaboration with the Northern Stars Head Coach and Assistant Coach of the individual development of identified athletes in the Northern Stars and Northern Comets.
5. Assist in holistic development for performance. This includes creating effective programme and training sessions that help to ensure individual athletes in the teams are technically, tactically, physically and mentally prepared to perform at a high level.
6. Assist the Head Coach in utilising technology to accurately analyse for skill development, identifying key development areas to successfully progress athletes into high performance netball.
7. In consultation with the Head Coach, contribute to the analysis of training & game data and video footage that will assist in the development of the athletes and the team game plans.
8. In consultation with the Head Coach, contribute to the analysis of opposition team strategies and individual athlete skills to provide key data for performance.
9. In consultation with the Head Coach, assist in the development of astute game strategies for opposing teams.
10. Provide observations to support the process of starting 7 selections and when in the position of Assistant Coach provide input into substitutions for match play.
11. Provide observations for individual player feedback.
12. Provide input into the succession plan for the Northern Stars.
13. Maintain confidentiality and discretion at all times.
